WELCOME BY GROUP LEADERS

2.0 WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK (WWCC) AND VOLUNTEERING IN THE JUNIOR SCHOOL

Mr Allan Stewart outlined the events requiring WWCC. This year the camp out overnight was replaced by the picnic day which was very successful and the camp out may have to be modified due to the WWCC requirements. He will continue to work through certain requirements and restrictions finalising WWCC for all events.

Dr Kate Hadwen's survey and focus groups will be vital insight into the school and the online survey has had over 76 per cent of parents complete it with roughly 400 pages of commentary regarding academic, co-curricular and social aspects. This will be a fantastic sample to be able to collate summaries and information which will be shared with the parents. Discussed car parking, car routes, pedestrian crossings and traffic issues, which the school is aware of and will continue to find better alternatives working with council and also the *Pymble* community.
