Summary of the Program

Classical Ballet is the foundation for all styles of dance. The Classical Ballet classes will follow the Royal Academy of Dance Syllabus and students may have the option to complete the formal examinations by an external examiner at the end of the year. Entry into this class is via invitation only from the selection classes held in Term 3, 2019. Late invitations are considered via email to dance@pymblelc.nsw.edu.au.

The graded syllabi provide a broad practical dance education progressively developing the technical, musical and performance skills of the student. Not all students are guaranteed entry into the RAD Ballet Examinations. All students wishing to register in Intermediate Foundation are required to register in the three classes. Students will learn the syllabus and a showcase dance in these classes.

All RAD Vocational grade students are required to complete a pre-pointe and follow up assessment at the teacher's discretion. This will be at an additional cost. Please refer to the Ballet Information Booklet for further information about Intermediate Foundation.
