Summary of the Program

Students will be guided by industry professionals to understand how movies are made and to experience this process first-hand by learning how to combine all the elements of the arts to create their own short films. Students are taught how to script, film, and edit, and can extend their skills and work alongside other students in other year levels.

These students will share their work at various showcase opportunities throughout the year, this will include the *Shakespeare Festival* in Term 2 2020 and also *On Camera*, the Co-curricular Film Showcase, in Term 4 2020, both held in the Gillian Moore Centre for Performing Arts. In addition to *Tropfest Junior*, student films will also be entered in external film competitions around NSW, nationally and internationally.
