

## UWS Kirby Cup Mooting Competition 2020

## Summary of the Program

The Mooting Competition is an event for Year 9 to 12 students to develop their advocacy skills in a competitive environment. The School of Law is inviting high school students in New South Wales to participate in the Kirby Cup Western Sydney University High School Mooting Competition in 2020. The registered high school mooting teams will be organised to compete against one another in a knockout competition, to be held at the University's Parramatta campus in October 2020. The grand final will be held in an official courtroom, usually at the Garfield Barwick Commonwealth Law Courts Building in Parramatta. The judges of the final will include current and/or former New South Wales and Federal Judges.

Pymble will register one team (up to a maximum of two teams) of four girls to represent us. The Mooting training and competition at Pymble provide a once in a lifetime chance for you to compete at the university level and develop your advocacy, public speaking and debating skills. Students will gain an in-depth understanding of the law, the meaning of legal reasoning and its application to real world situations. We encourage students with a strong interest in law to audition for this wonderful opportunity.
