Snowsports is a unique sport at *Pymble*. Students across all years get the opportunity to bond and share the experience of Snowsports training and competition. It is a sport where girls from the Preparatory, Junior and Secondary Schools can cheer each other on, celebrate, congratulate and admire each other's successes, no matter how large or small. It is also a sport where the whole family is involved; where families come together in the wonderful alpine environment to share great times.

Pymble Snowsports is not about creating champions, it is about life-long friendships for both students and parents; enjoying the thrill of competition; being in a team; learning how to ski and snowboard on all terrains with confidence and rising to challenge. Team members only need basic skiing or snowboarding skills to give this competition a try. It is all about participation and fun. That said, the team proudly boasts some of the best skiers in the country for their age group.

The *Pymble* Snowsports program is based around the Interschools Snowsports Championships. This sees students compete for their school as part of a team or as an individual. There are four separate competitions and team members can progress from the Northern Region Championships based on their results (see below for dates)
