



Animation – Years 5 and 6

Summary of the Program

Students will be guided by industry professionals to understand how movies are made and to experience this process first-hand by learning how to combine all the elements of the arts to create their own digital animation. Students are taught how to script, film, and edit, and can extend their skills and work alongside other students in other year levels.

These students will share their work at end-of-term informal parent showcases and will also work on a film to showcase in Term 4 2019, in the Co-Curricular Film Showcase, *On Camera*, held in the Gillian Moore Centre for Performing Arts. Students films will also be entered in external film competitions around NSW and Australia.
