

Artistic Gymnastics White Squad - Intermediate

White Squad is designed for students who show a significant natural aptitude for gymnastics. This program has been established by Gymnastics Australia to guide and develop students along a structured pathway towards an international level of gymnastics in the future, combining competitive levels alongside skills testing to monitor progress.

White Squad – Intermediate is for students wish to compete at club, invitational, State and National based events, striving towards competing at the elite level and gaining selection on the NSW State Squads for International Levels or undertaking an accelerated pathway for the National Levels program.

Students with successful skill and strength testing results will be selected to represent Pymble Ladies' College at club, invitational, State and National based events, competing in the National or International Levels Program and will also have the opportunity to gain selection onto the NSW State Squads.

Students training schedule will be developed in consultation with the Artistic Gymnastics Head Coach. Students in this program will also participate in one ballet session per week and one strength and conditioning session per week.

Program Dates (Start/End)	Student start and end dates for competitive students vary due to competition schedules. Students in White Squads - Intermediate train 36 weeks of the year, which includes all term dates.
	Holiday gymnastics is included within the annual fee, however there will be allocated weeks off e.g. Christmas / New Year period, in addition to a number of other weeks.
Uniform/Equipment	All students training in the Competitive Artistic Gymnastics Program must wear a leotard and/or crop top and bike pants to training. This is required for safety reasons so that the coach can help your daughter correctly when teaching her new skills and shapes.
	A full equipment list will be provided in the 2017 Artistic Gymnastics Handbook.
	Please also note that all gymnasts are expected to tie up their hair neatly and tightly for gymnastics. If your daughter has long hair, please ensure that is it tied up for safety reasons. Please pack spare elastics and clips in your daughter's gymnastics bag and the coaches can fix hair at the beginning of training if required.
