

Creative Photography (Years 9 to 11)

In this Creative Photography course, students will apply a hands-on approach to techniques in digital photography and the photographic Darkroom. Students who have completed the Foundations of Photography I course can continue to apply their technical and artistic knowledge and will be challenged with more advanced processes. Weekly photographic briefs will be set, exploring various photographic genres including mastering the 'science of light' in the school's photography lighting studio. The course will finish with an introduction to the Darkroom, where students will explore the timeless camera-less techniques of cyanotype making and photograms.

The Creative Photography course combines artistic projects with technical knowledge, which will equip Senior students with advanced technical and creative skills needed to produce stunning imagery. It is perfect for both intermediate, as well as the more experienced 'photographers' looking to discover the creative flexibility of working within digital, analogue and camera-less photographic mediums. To help students view, edit and process their digital files, they will be working in Adobe Lightroom or Photoshop (no prior knowledge required). Students will finish with a small folio of resolved works.

The Facilitator: Nikki Easterbrook is a Photomedia Artist and a recent graduate of the Sydney College of Art. She holds a Bachelor of Visual Arts (Hons) in Photography and a Graduate Diploma in Photo-imaging from Sydney TAFE. Nikki has over 15 years of professional photography experience, working in Asia and Australia, and is the recipient of several prestigious photography awards. Her work has been selected for numerous group exhibitions at SH Irvin Gallery, 101 Projects, Verge Gallery, SCA Gallery and the Regent Street Gallery.
