



Foundations of Photography

In this Foundations of Photography course, students apply a hands-on approach to techniques in digital and analogue photography. The course begins with an introduction to creative digital capture using their own DSLR cameras, studio lighting for portrait photography and still life. To help students view, edit and process their digital files, they will be working in Adobe Lightroom (no prior knowledge required). The course will then finish with an introduction to analogue photography where students will explore the techniques of the black and white printing process in the school's darkroom.

The Foundations of Photography course is hands-on, combining creative projects, which will equip students with the basic technical and creative skills needed to take stunning professional images. It is perfect for both beginners as well as the more experienced 'photographers' looking to discover the creative flexibility of working within manual mode. Students will finish with a small folio of resolved works.

The Facilitator: Nikki Easterbrook is a Photomedia Artist and a recent graduate of the Sydney College of Art. She holds a Bachelor of Visual Arts (Hons) in Photography and a Graduate Diploma in Photo-imaging from Sydney TAFE. Nikki has over 15 years of professional photography experience working in Asia and Australia and is the recipient of several prestigious photography awards. Her work has been selected for numerous group exhibitions at SH Irvin Gallery, 101 Projects, Verge Gallery, SCA Gallery and the Regent Street Gallery.
