

Watercolour Painting

Watercolour Painting at Pymble is open to all students in Years 7 to 12. Watercolour Painting provides an opportunity to learn the practical skills and techniques of watercolour paint. Students will learn about paint application, brush work and colour mixing and how these skills can be applied to fine art, lettering, illustration and design. Students can work from an image or their imagination, and each student will learn how to create a painting from the initial layout and sketching stage through to completion with an experienced teacher. All materials are supplied.

This activity will also be available for registration in Term 3 and 4 (Semester 2); days, times and teachers will be released at the end of Term 2.
