

Tap (Year 1 and 2)

Tap dance is a form of dance characterised by a tapping sound that is created from metal plates attached to both the ball and heel of the dancer's shoe. These metal plates, when tapped against a suitable surface, create a percussive sound. The Tap class will be a combination of old and modern tap styles.
