



Bond University National Mooting Competition

The National High School Mooting Competition is an event for Year 11 and 12 students to develop their advocacy skills in a competitive environment. Each year approximately 80 of Australia's most prominent schools participate in an intense competition held over a fortnight at Bond University. Pymble will register one team (up to a maximum of two teams) of three girls to represent us. Bond University will pay for all travel and accommodation during the fortnight competition.

The preliminary rounds will be held from Tuesday, 8 May to Friday, 18 May 2018 and will take place on the Bond University campus on the Gold Coast. The National Grand Final will be held on Saturday, 2 June 2018. The national competition brings together schools from every state and territory who battle it out in front of real judges, barristers and members of the legal profession and academe.

The Mooting training and competition at Pymble provide a once in a lifetime chance for you to compete at the national level and develop your advocacy, public speaking and debating skills. Students will gain an in-depth understanding of the law, the meaning of legal reasoning and its application to real-world situations. We encourage students with a strong interest in law to audition for this wonderful opportunity.
