



Public Speaking Classes

The Public Speaking course is designed for students who would like to improve their skills and extend their opportunities in Public Speaking. Both experienced and novice Public Speakers are welcome. Students will be guided through the skills of Public Speaking from experienced coaches and will explore speaking in public from a theoretical and practical perspective. We will explore the three pillars of rhetoric: Ethos, Pathos and Logos; analyse some famous speeches and construct and present our own. Class activities will focus on individual students and their point of need. Participants will also have the opportunity to observe a Regional Final of the Rostrum Public Speaking competition, being hosted by *Pymble* in early May 2018.
