



Touch Typing

Much of text your child will write during her lifetime will be done on a keyboard! Touch Typing is a commitment to learning correct finger placement on the keyboard to build muscle memory in the fingers whilst not looking at the keyboard. This is not learnt overnight, but it can be learned. Students will be making a commitment to a skill they will have and use accurately for life.

Each student has their own online account in this course which holds all their course progress, accuracy and test results so improvement can be monitored. Students work at their own pace to complete exercises whilst tutors encourage and motivate students in a fun, learning environment. Lessons focus around the correct posture, hand, finger and wrist placement and accurately learning how to type each key without looking at the keyboard.

Teaching school students this skill early will improve their computer skills for research, presentations in class, assignments, familiarity around keyboards and computers and so much more. Touch Typing is a Life Skill that once learned, has incalculable value throughout life.
