



Touch Typing

The majority of text your child will write during her lifetime will be done on a keyboard!

The Junior School Touch Typing program will run in Terms 1 to 4 offering students the opportunity to develop this valuable life skill before they reach Secondary School.

Each student has their own online account which holds all their course progress, accuracy and test results, so improvement can be monitored. They all work at their own pace to complete exercises whilst tutors encourage and motivate students in a fun, learning environment. Lessons focus around the correct posture, hand, finger and wrist placement.

Teaching Junior School students this skill early will improve their computer skills for research, presentations in class, assignments, familiarity around keyboards and computers, and so much more.

Touch Typing is a life skill that once learned, has incalculable value throughout life abilities.
