Students are expected to:

- Fulfill a full year's commitment to their ensemble/s
- Junior Jazz members are required to be committed members of the Grainger Band
- Attend all weekly rehearsals and tutorials
- Practice their ensemble music regularly and demonstrate satisfactory progress on their chosen instrument
- Arrive promptly to all rehearsals, tutorials and performances
- Provide their tutor/conductor with a written explanation from home if absent from or late to a rehearsals, tutorial or performance for any reason
- Show genuine interest in and commitment to learning a band instrument.
- Behave with respect, responsibility and friendliness at all times

The aims of the Junior School Band Program are:

- To introduce students to the basic skills involved in playing a band instrument
- To extend each student's performance and ensemble skills through participation in a Concert Band
- To develop and foster a love of music in all students by conducting rehearsals and tutorials in a supportive and encouraging learning environment

Private Instrumental Music Lessons are to be arranged individually by parents and are available for all band instruments through the school. However, students may have lessons outside the school from a qualified music teacher (if preferred). Private Music Lessons for next year can be applied for at any time of the year via the College website.

Instrument hire/buy

Members of the Grainger Band are expected to provide their own instrument with the exception of the larger, more expensive or more unusual instruments such as: tenor sax, french horn, trombone and euphonium.
