

MUSIC PERFORMANCE UNIFORM

All Instrumental Ensembles and Pymble Chorale

As part of the commitment to an ensemble, students are required to wear a special Performance Uniform when performing at most events. This requires hiring a red Performance Jacket and *Pymble* suit bag, and purchasing a black Music Performance T-shirt. The total cost of the Music Performance Uniform Pack is \$180.00.

When students no longer require the Performance Jacket, it is to be returned together with the *Pymble* suit bag within one month to the Music Office. Depending on the number of years hired, a refund less \$15.00 per year of hire will be credited to your College account on return of the jacket with proof of dry cleaning. If not returned cleaned with documentary proof, \$20.00 will be deducted from the refund amount to cover a cleaning surcharge. Students may swap their Performance Jacket for a different size at no extra cost if the need arises at any time. The Music Performance T-shirt does not need to be returned.

How is my Performance Uniform worn?







- Long hair needs to be tied back neatly off the face, half up half down with black hair ribbons. Please no scrunchies or buns. In extreme heat, hair may be worn in braids or a ponytail with correct hair ribbon.
- Red Performance Jacket worn over full length black pants (students own choice – not dance pants, skinny leg jeans, leggings, cargo or cropped pants)
- Enclosed black shoes with black socks or stockings (low heeled or flat black slip on/court shoes are preferable but clean shiny school shoes are acceptable. No peep toes, sling backs or slides)
- Black Performance T-shirt to be worn under red Performance Jacket. On some occasions, the black Performance T-shirt is worn without the jacket.
