Position Purpose and Objectives

The Artistic Gymnastics will assist with the supervision, mentoring and training of Pymble Ladies' College students.

Core Job Role Accountabilities

1. Coaching

- 1.1 Monitor and coach each student to improve their technical skill.
- 1.2 Regularly assess, monitor and provide feedback to each student.
- 1.3 Provide clear, concise and motivating information to teams prior to competing.
- 1.4 Provide effective feedback to gymnasts after competitions to improve performance.
- 1.5 Work collaboratively with the other coaches to help create coaching team cohesion.
- 1.6 Attend and contribute to coaches meetings, as required.
- 1.7 Work with the scope of current coaching accreditation – specifically, only coaches with advanced qualifications are permitted to teach acrobatic flight and salto elements.

2. Communication

- 1.1 Ensure all written and verbal communication is courteous, professional, accurate and reflective of College values.

3. Risk and Compliance

- 2.1 Report directly to the Principal on any matters relating to child protection.

2.2 Consistently adhere to College policies and procedures, importantly the Risk Management, WHS, Child Protection and our emergency response practices.
